This Memorandum of Agreement made on this 2nd day of February in the year 2023 and signed between:

- I Universitas Pancasila by the Faculty of Pharmacy**, located on Srengseng Sawah, Jagakarsa Jakarta Selatan, Indonesia, represented by **Prof. Dr. apt. Syamsudin, M.Biomed.**, Dean, Faculty of Pharmacy, Universitas Pancasila based on the Universitas Pancasila Rector Decree No. 2633/S.KEP.R/UP/VII/2022 dated on July 5th, 2022, in this matter acting for and behalf of Universitas Pancasila, hereinafter referred to as “**First Party**”;
- II Mahidol University by the Faculty of Pharmacy**, located on 447 Si Ayutthaya Rd., Thung Phaya Thai, Ratchathewi, Bangkok 10400, Thailand, represented by **Assoc. Prof. Surakit Nathisuwan, Pharm. D.**, Dean, Faculty of Pharmacy, Mahidol University, hereinafter referred to as “**Second Party**”.

First Party and Second Party, hereinafter collectively referred to as “**The Parties**” and singular referred to as “**The Party**”, agree to establish their cooperative relationship, hereinafter referred to as “**Agreement**”.

Article 1

Modes of Collaboration

The Parties have agreed to collaboration in the following areas:

1. Academic/Education
2. Researches
3. Community Service

Article 2

Purposes of The Agreement

1. The Parties are willing to promote mutual interest through cooperation on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.
2. The cooperation shall promote academic international knowledge and support the friendly relationship between The Parties.
3. The Agreement and the Annexes to this Agreement (if any) form part of Memorandum of Understanding between The Parties, signed on February 2, 2023.....

Article 3

Scope of Cooperation

1. Exchange of student and lecturers;
2. Exchange of faculty and administrative staff, laboratory analyst;
3. Collaborative research project, lectures, symposia, seminars, workshops, etc.;
4. Exchange of academic information and materials;
5. Collaboration in instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interest and shared access to information networks; and
6. Guest lecturer and visiting professor

The details of the project and the specific activity implemented under this Agreement shall be mutually discussed, agreed and formalized in a separate written agreement by The Parties prior to the initiation of that Project or activity.

Article 4

Rights and Obligations

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practice of each institution as well as the law and regulations of the host country.
2. The receiving Party will bear accommodation for lecturer or professor during the activity.
3. Each party will provide teaching materials.

Article 5

Force Majeure

1. What is meant by coercive conditions in this cooperation Agreement are all states of force, i.e. circumstances or event such as natural disasters, war, and other events beyond the ability of The Parties to overcome.
2. The notice of the majeure as referred to in paragraph (1) above shall be a written letter from the relevant institution/authority maximum 7 (seven) days from the occurrence of the majeure state.
3. In the event of a state of force, the all consequences and risks arising shall be borne together, without being able to make mutual claims between The Parties.

Article 6

Support of Agreement and Correspondence

1. It is understood that the Parties shall support and promote the spirit of this Agreement to encourage academic collaboration and to facilitate as much as possible to academic progress, physical relocation, and cultural orientation of all exchange students.
2. Any notice required to be given by the Party under this Agreement shall be given in writing, shall be deemed given when actually received by the other Party, and shall be conveyed via e-mail or private courier as follows:

Article 7

Dispute of Resolution

1. Any disputes, controversy or claim that arises out of, or in connection with this Agreement, shall be amicably through mutual negotiation to the extent possible between the Parties.
2. In the event the Parties fail to resolve any dispute arising hereunder through mutual negotiation, the dispute shall be submitted to and finally resolved by arbitration.

Article 8

Duration of Agreement

1. This Agreement will operate from the date of signing for five years and may be subjected to revision or modification by mutual agreement.
2. This Agreement may be revised by mutual consent or terminated by either university, provided advance notice at least 90 (ninety) days prior to the termination date.

Article 9

Closing

1. This Agreement is made in only English language.
2. The terms under which these cooperative must be conducted are by default organized and administrated according to the terms and conditions established in the English language version of the contract, Memorandum of Understanding or Memorandum of Agreement.
3. Should there be any discrepancies amongst the language versions of contract, Memorandum of Understanding or Memorandum of Agreement, regardless of the nature of the discrepancy, the English language version shall be agreed upon as the final arbiter and takes precedence over all other language version.
